

**Dulce Independent School District
Student Dress and Appearance Code**

These specific changes are in effect for the 2010 – 2011 school year. It is at the discretion of the building administrator(s) to require a student to change his/her attire and/or confiscate any attire, which are in conflict with this policy.

A student's dress and appearance shall not present health and/or safety problems or cause disruption of educational activities.

All clothing must be modest and of appropriate size.

- No low cut or revealing outfits,
- no spaghetti straps,
- no oversized or sagging clothing. (Back pockets on pants must be on buttocks.)
- no tattoos or clothing, which may be considered offensive which depict (non-inclusive listing): alcohol, drugs, gangs, thug life, sex, obscenities, Satanic themes, racism, violence, blood/gore/skulls, inappropriate slogans, teeth grills, dog collars, Scarface or Snowman.
- No Gothic attire, dark sometimes morbid, eroticized including: (non-inclusive listing)
 - black dyed and crimped hair,
 - black make-up,
 - all black clothing, and/or
 - chains, and spikes.
- No gang related dress including: (non-inclusive listing)
 - bandanas, uneven pant lengths, gang related jewelry, graffiti, symbols, codes,
 - no towels or shirts hanging from pocket or on shoulder, and/or
 - no hair designs and shaved insignias which are gang related.

The following accessories are not permissible indoors including: (non-inclusive listing)

- sunglasses, hats, caps, hoods on hoodies, stockings, du rags, bandanas, sweatbands, gloves or other hand coverings, towels, and/or
- no piercing that presents health and/or safety problems or cause disruption, including but not limited to, lip rings, eyebrow rings, and/or ear stretchers.
