21st CCLC DREAMS After School Programs begin Monday, August 29, 2011, and end Thursday, May 13, 2012 for students. Staff members will start a bit earlier with a one day after school orientation and training session on Wednesday, August 24, 2011, from 3:45 PM to 5:15 PM.

The after school program will be Mondays through Thursdays (*Thursdays for educational assistants only*) from 3:30 PM until 5:30 PM for staff members. The K-5 program will be at the elementary school; the 6-8 program will be at the middle school; and our 9-12 students will have their program at the high school. Certified teachers receive \$25.00 per hour, and non-certified receive \$20.00 per hour. **If you do not have an after school/extended day application on file at the business office, you must submit one with this form. Interviews will be scheduled for new applicants before the program begins.** All applications are available at the Administration Building.

If you are interested in working for our extended day programs this school year, please check the box on the bottom of this sheet, sign your name, and give it to me by August 16, 2011. I have mailboxes at each building site, but my main office is located at the Administration Building. Remember, signing this form only means you are interested in working during the after school program. The site directors and director make employment recommendations, and final approval will come from Superintendent Lesher.
