#1 in Learning

#1 in Learning (#1L) provides tutoring for K-12 students in mathematics, reading, and English language arts. Our desire is to groom the character and learning abilities of our students in order to help them meet and conquer the challenges of their educational career. We work with basic needs, special needs, and English Language learners through high quality instruction, 1 on 1 and small group settings, and motivational support. We schedule sessions in your home or at a local library.

#1 in Learning Online

#1 in Learning Online(#1LO) provides one on one online tutoring for K-12 students in mathematics, reading, and English language arts. Our desire is to groom the character and learning abilities of our students in order to help them meet and conquer the challenges of their educational career. We work with basic needs, special needs, and English Language learners through a high quality instructional web-based program called Study Island. Students have the convenience of setting their own schedule by accessing the web-based program via an internet connected device (tablet/laptop) provided for by #1LO. Tablets/laptops, software subscription, and internet connection are paid for by #1LO. There are no expenses to the parents when using our online program. #1LO charges \$65/hr or less(to the LEA) for our online program. Students must maintain access of at least 2 hours per week for successful completion of our program.

1:1 Online Tutoring Services

Tutoring is done on the online platform. For those students who do not have a laptop or access to the Internet we provide them with the same free of cost. The salient features of our tutoring program includes one to one instruction, live tutoring, use of state aligned curriculum, flexibility, high quality researched material, experienced tutors, convenient, continuous monitoring of student's progress and involvement of teachers and parents at each step of the student's development. Classes are conducted 2 to 3 times a week with each class being of 60 to 90 minutes duration. Our virtual classroom has a whiteboard which has a set of teaching tools to teach students synchronously over the Internet. It is used to promote communication, collaboration and understanding among students. We conduct pre assessment tests for each of our student to gauge the topics they need help with and also post assessment tests to measure the effectiveness of our program. We use PLATO® eduTest to assess the student's strengths and weaknesses and develop Student Learning Plans and a focused timetable. The parents are provided with progress reports on a bi-weekly basis. Our program has served more than 1000 students in the past year. The typical profiles of the students we tutor each year are those who belong to low-income group. We have extensive experience working with such students and also have expert tutors who use their skills to teach IEP students effectively.

100 Scholars

100 Scholars provides free tutoring for students in grades K-12 in Reading and for students in grades 1-12 in Math. We offer in-person tutoring for individual instruction (ratio of 1 student to 1 tutor) and small-group instruction (ratio of 2–5 students to 1 tutor). Tutoring sessions are offered each day of the week and are held at a time that works best for parents and families, including before school, after school, and on weekends. We provide supervised tutoring in the student's home, at the student's school, or at a nearby location such as a public library, place of religious worship, or community center. 100 Scholars uses high quality curriculum from Triumph Learning and Encore. Curriculum is both paper-and-pencil and computer-based to make learning fun and to keep students interested.

100 Scholars provides all instructional materials and technology needed for tutoring. Our tutors monitor student progress daily, and are available on an ongoing basis to discuss student progress. We send parents formal progress reports monthly and at program's end. Program information and progress reports are available in English and/or Spanish. Our tutors have at least a bachelor's degree, and most are state-certified teachers. Our staff are experienced helping students improve their scores in school. We offer tutoring services in almost 90 school districts across New Mexico.

24/7 Educate Online

We provide students with the interactive web-based software Compass Learning Odyssey (CLO) from CompassLearning.com. Odyssey's curriculum is aligned with New Mexico Academic Standards. We provide laptop and internet connection free of cost to every student. We can serve all school districts in New Mexico. The highlight of our program for children who are performing significantly below grade level is that the students can work at their own pace, listening to directions as many times as they require. Students can replay instructions as many times as they want while attempting activities, quizzes etc. The instructional approach behind designing the software is direct instructions and scaffolded learning. Media rich content and flash based activities help keep the learner engaged while grasping important concepts. Each student is provided a username and password to access our program 24x7 and assigned a tutor who works with him/her in the program. They interact with students once a week to clarify doubts, discuss skills/concepts they are facing difficulty with. Our program can be accessed using PC and Mac in the student's home via internet on a laptop computer. We recommend using the software for a minimum of one hour on a daily basis. The hours can be increased as per the student's convenience. The student can take help more than once a week on prior appointment with the tutor.

Tutors are required to have a four year college degree and minimum one year experience dealing with Title 1, ELL, and/or students with special needs. In an effort to ensure that our tutors are capable of improving student's academic achievement, we hire tutors with teaching certifications and teaching experiences who are subject matter experts in the discipline they tutor. The qualifications of all tutors meet our high program standards and core values.

Academic Tutoring Service

At Academic Tutoring Service (ATS), we provide secular, neutral, and non-ideological tutoring services to students enrolled in grades K-12, in the subject areas of reading, writing, mathematics, and English as a second language. Tutoring services are provided after school, weekends, summer at schools, at community centers, In-home, public libraries, or one of our ATS Centers in either individualized or group settings. The program model uses relationship building by the tutor with the student to facilitate the student's hope and enthusiasm for learning, thus engaging the student in the tutoring services. The ATS Program provides a tutoring infrastructure of educational services that are consistent with the State of New Mexico Standards of Education and has experience working with diverse populations and with special education, English language learner, and 504 students. All tutors will be fully licensed teachers or paraprofessionals who met the Title I educational requirements. Instructors will be working at a pupil-tutor ratio of no greater than 8/1. ATS will use the New Mexico Core Standard as objectives and benchmarks as a guide for the core curriculum and mode of instructional delivery. Tutoring instruction meets these benchmarks by utilizing curriculum that addresses all goals and standards. Tutoring sessions are designed to follow a roadmap, beginning with the first achievement goal outlined for the session. Once a student masters a goal, they progress forward to the next goal. The roadmap incorporates different learning modalities and curriculum derived from Houghton-Mifflin –New Mexico addition, which are supplied by Academic Tutoring Service to assist students in achieving their goals. Sessions are structured to begin with short mini-lessons, such as speed-reading, before progressing into the core academic tutoring, which incorporates the curricula and relia (hands-on activities) to focus on the achievement goal. Sessions end with a short activity that reinforces progress the student has made during the session. Informal assessments (Ex. chapter quizzes) determine where achievement has been made and how to progress to the next goal. Students attend 2 sessions per week for 1.5 to 2.0 hours per session with the cost of approximately 55.00 per hour allowing for 20/30 hours per cycle. The ATS Program's model of instructional delivery represents a cycle of effective individual instruction, on-going assessments, monitoring for student progress and evaluating student performance to improve students learning. The program executes this model by performing informal and formal assessments during the course of tutoring to check for student's progress and monitor students learning during direct and independent learning. The nature of ATS's program allows for easy and convenient communication with the student and the parent/guardian and creates an atmosphere that encourages open communication. We are extremely flexible in finding the right schedule that accommodates both the child and the parent, however no transportation will be provided. The student, parent/guardian, teacher and school actively participate in the development of the SLP. Through the course of the tutoring sessions, the student, parent/guardian, school and district are provided with continual progress reports detailing all activities performed to meet the SLP goals. After each tutoring session, the tutor inputs their notes in our database, OASES, outlining the lesson objective(s), curricula and/or mode of instruction utilized and outcome comments from the tutor. Academic Tutoring Service's goal is to provide quality service, which will assist students in achieving academic excellence!

ATS Project Success

ATS Project Success offers eligible K-12 students tutoring in English language arts (including reading) and mathematics for all districts in New Mexico. We offer services online in the comfort and safety of each student's home with a loaned, pre-programmed computer (PC) and Internet service (dial-up, or through a T-Mobile or Verizon cellular connection) at no cost to the families. School districts will be charged \$60/hour per student for tutoring, assessed in 15-minute increments. Students in grades K-8 and those that perform below the ninth grade instructional level will use the SuccessMaker® curriculum and students in grades 9-12 and those that perform above an eighth grade instructional level will use the Odyssey© curriculum. Students are assessed by the program to determine their instructional level and learning objectives. Students are encouraged to complete two one-hour sessions per week. Any student that can use a computer can use our program, including English Language Learners and students with disabilities. All of our tutors are required to have a teaching certificate. The assigned tutor monitors student progress online and follows-up with calls to the student and his/her parents once each week. Our Spanish and Hmong translators assist in communicating with families who speak those languages. We also provide parents and school district staff with monthly written reports (English/Spanish/Hmong) and work with schools and teachers to make sure the student's efforts in our program are helping them succeed in the classroom as well.

Babbage Net School

BTTX, LP dba Babbage Net School provides one-on-one, English and Math tutoring via laptop computer to students in grades K-12. No internet connection is required. Our program uses the A+nyWhere Learning System tutoring software and curriculum, which gives students the freedom to tutor at their own pace, in their own home, using a laptop computer and curriculum that is customized to meet individual academic needs. Our entire curriculum contains about 5,000 English and Math lessons totaling over 100,000 exercises and 9,000 hours of instruction. Once enrolled, students take a pre-assessment test to identify areas where they need the most help. These results are used to create a personalized curriculum which is installed on a laptop computer and delivered to the student. There is no time limit to complete a lesson. However, students must receive 80% or higher on the end of lesson test to advance to the next lesson. Student progress is monitored on a weekly basis, and the progress is reported to parents and teachers on a monthly basis. These student progress reports include lessons completed, time spent on each lesson, lesson quiz scores, learning objectives achieved, and any comments/notes from the student's tutor. After completing the program, students take a post-assessment to determine their overall progress. The hourly cost of our program is \$65.00 and we will be serving fifty-seven (57) districts in New Mexico. Our program also provides a toll-free Help Hotline for additional support. Our tutors are trained and certified by the National Tutoring Association (NTA). Our Help Hotline is available Mon-Fri from 3:00 PM and 8:00 PM. Overall, our instructional software and one-on-one support provides students a completely personalized tutoring program that will meet their exact needs and can be completed on their own schedule.

Educate Online Learning, LLC

Educate Online Learning, LLC is America's leading provider of live, personalized, at-home tutoring. Educate Online has successfully served more than 52,000 students since 2002. All tutoring takes place online, and Educate Online will provide computers and arrange internet access, if needed, at no charge. Students log on to a virtual classroom from home, while their instructor logs on from another location. Students and teachers can speak directly to one another and are able to view the same desktop, so they can work together effectively. All sessions are taught by U.S. state-certified teachers with at least two years of successful teaching experience. On average, students who complete either our math or reading program gain a grade level in skills. Students typically take two to four 60-minute sessions each week. Sessions are offered seven days a week, after school and on weekends. Families are able to choose the days and times that work best for them. At Eduwizards all online tutoring is one-to-one and can be conveniently taken from student's home. We provide free computers to students who don't have one and also pay the internet bill. Our tutors are USA-based and most of them are state certified, with a Master's degree or higher. Tutoring takes place using our virtual classroom, which includes whiteboard, text, and voice chat. The classroom size is one student and one instructor which allows for maximum concentration, focus, and attention. All our sessions are recorded online and available for later viewing by students, parents and tutors. To carefully monitor student progress Eduwizards has devised a two-education-experts per student system (one being the tutor and the other the tutor-coordinator). They continuously work together to come up with solutions to customize the tutoring to best suit the individual student's needs. Student satisfaction and improvement is our highest priority. We have an open review system where after each online session the student has an option to review the tutor. This helps Eduwizards to openly identify and retain only the best online tutors, who have an excellent record of teaching ability and student communication. Along with instruction, continuous online assessments are conducted to map student progress and identify areas of strength and weakness. Regular studies conducted using pre-assessment and post-assessment show marked improvement in the performance of our students. The effectiveness of our program is further demonstrated by the fact that our website is full of great reviews from satisfied students and parents.

A state aligned curriculum, established Assessment Test, and researched instructional strategies have enabled GradeCracker to provide high quality, individualized and focused tutoring in a safe online environment. A computer with an internet connection is provided free of cost for low income students and those who do not already have one so that they are able to benefit from our online classes. Our program addresses the needs of students in English Reading and Math for grades K-12. Since our tutoring sessions are provided online, transportation is not applicable on us. Our instructions are delivered online and therefore students with disabilities having problem traveling can easily avail our services from their homes, under their parents care. We use self-developed curriculum which is aligned with New Mexico State Academic Standards. For the purpose of assessing student weaknesses we administer online assessment tests – GRADE and GMADE developed by Pearson Education Inc. We form an individualized learning plan from the report generated by the diagnostic test & subsequent discussion with district, school personnel and parents, which specifically caters to the student's academic needs. Each tutoring session is provided online, 1:1 session, 90 minutes long, with 2 – 3 tutoring sessions in a week. Our program lasts for 25 – 30 hours for \$60 rate per hour. We have successfully delivered instruction to students with disabilities and English language learners. For special needs students we use special techniques such as repetition, highlights and bigger fonts to emphasize a concept. Also, we obtain a copy of the student's IEP/ Section 504 Plan from the school and develop our learning plan taking it into consideration and after a consultation with the student's teachers.

Our program promotes the foundational knowledge students need to succeed in today's world. In those instances where computers are not available KPS will work directly with that particular school (and/or district) to supply students with laptop computers that can be used and stored on-site.

Northern New Mexico Network, Passport to Success Tutoring Program

The Northern New Mexico Network provides small group tutoring (no more than three students per teacher) in mathematics, reading, and writing. Tutoring occurs before or after school at the student's school with licensed teachers. Normally, teachers are from the student's school. The Network will review student's test scores and develop a program based on the student's needs and state standards. Our goal is to accelerate academic performance by six months in an eight week period. This is our expectation for students with an excellent attendance record. Total number of service hours will depend on district's per student cap. The current range is 12-80 tutoring hours.

Tutorial Services is a company that offers a web-based solution, the program we use is called CompassLearning. This is our fifth year of service as a supplemental education provider. We will provide your child with everything necessary to access our program, including a computer. Our program from K-12, in reading, math, and science, operates 24/7 and your child can access their work at anytime. Our qualified tutors will monitor your child's work and report every two (2) weeks on their progress. In order to properly assess your student they will need to take the CompassLearning pretest and post test. We align each child's activities to these tests. We feel that each child has a different way of learning and some need more help than others, therefore, we offer the program free of charge all the way through August of the following year. We provide the tools necessary for them to be successful in tomorrow's world. Our slogan, "Making a Difference, One Student at a Time," is our promise to your child and you.

TutoringOne

TutoringOne effectively links the technology children crave with the instruction they need. The K-12 online mathematics and reading services are provided in the home of the student. The assessment adapts to the skills and responses of the student to improve accuracy and reduce student frustration. All lessons are tailored specifically for the unique learning profile of each student. Students should work on the program at least twice a week for one hour. The high-quality video lessons are student-friendly and align to state standards. The lessons include high-interest materials, manipulatives, models, real-world problems and age-appropriate games to engage and motivate students throughout the program.
