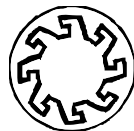


PURPOSE

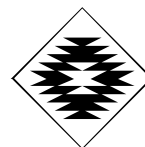
The Institute aims to support youth and parent leadership, create partnerships that can improve school programs and climate, and influence policies that affect parental involvement programs across the state.

A wide range of workshop sessions will be available in English, Spanish and Native American languages when possible.

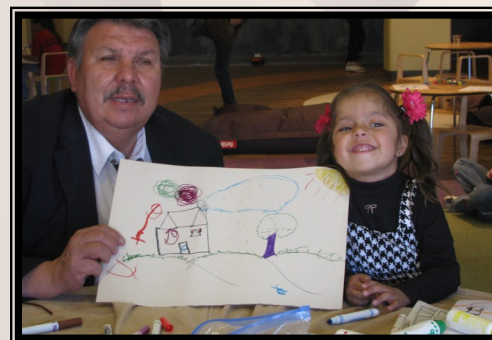
