

First day of school - August 11, Wednesday due to forest fire and smoke danger.

- Packet pick-up only for first week - computers *should* be ready next week (Aug. 16-20)
- **Lunches** will be ready at 9:30 am

August 12 & 13, Thursday & Friday

- **Group 2** (Thursday/Friday group) attends school in person from 8 am to 3:45 pm.
- **All drop off students must remain in the vehicle until they have been cleared and confirmed to attend school.**
 - This means their temperature must be checked. Right now the “go home” temp is from the CDC at 100.4
 - Student names must be on the **Group 2** (Thursday/Friday group) rosters for confirmation that they can exit the vehicle to attend school.
- **Group 1** (Monday/Tuesday group) and **Group 3** (100% virtual students) do not attend virtually, this week only, but complete their packets at home. No computers yet.
- **Lunches** will be ready at 9:30 am each day
- **PACKET DAYS ARE NOW THE FRIDAY PREVIOUS THE WEEK OF THAT PACKET’S INSTRUCTION**

Week 2 - August 16-20

- **Group 1** attends school in person from 8 am to 3:45 pm on Monday and Tuesday
- **All drop off students must remain in the vehicle until they have been cleared and confirmed to attend school.**
 - Temperatures must be checked. Right now the “go home” temp is from the CDC at 100.4
 - Student names must be on the **Group 1** (Monday/Tuesday group) rosters for confirmation that they can exit the vehicle to attend school.
- **Groups 2 & 3** - Attend school virtually between 8 am and 3:45 pm, according to teacher schedules
- **Lunches** can be picked up at the elementary at 9:30 am.

- **All three groups attend school virtually on Wednesdays - Sanitation Day - from 8 am - 2 pm**
- **Lunches** can be picked up at the elementary at 9:30 am.

- **Group 2** attends school in person from 8 am to 3:45 pm on Thursday and Friday
- **All drop off students must remain in the vehicle until they have been cleared and confirmed to attend school.**
- **Groups 1 & 3** - Attend school virtually between 8 am and 3:45 pm, according to teacher schedules
- **GOAL:** Laptops ready for check out and for students to keep at home for school use only. Parents will be contacted for check out times. Charges for damages to school property will be noted upon School Board approval. Technology agreement must be signed before checkout.
- **Pick up student packets on Friday between 7:45 am and 5:30 pm.**
- **Lunches** can be picked up at the elementary at 9:30 am.

Virtual agreements and school supply lists are available on the school website and as a hard copy at the round table at the elementary entrance.

Visitors in the building are extremely limited, due to COVID restrictions. If your temperature is above 99.5 degrees, do not enter the building. Have someone come in for you.

- **Only Pre-K family members** are allowed to enter the building to pick up their child.
- **Afterschool pick-up** has changed - remain in your vehicle and a DES staff person will ask for your student's name and grade then call the student out. This will take longer than usual, but it is to limit contact. Your patience is appreciated.
- **Virtual parent visitors** are highly encouraged - make sure you help keep noise and visual distractions to a minimum.
- **Packet Pick-Up** will only be on FRIDAY's this year between 7:45 am and 5:30 pm. Sign in, write in your temperature, pick-up your child(ren)'s packets, and follow the one-way path marked out for you on the way out of the building. By the third week of school, only 100% virtual students and absent students should need packet pick-up. All other students will be receiving their packets in advance when they attend school.
- **Take Out Lunches** will be ready each day by 9:30 am for students attending school virtually.

IN School:

- Anyone entering the main entrance must sign in and note their temperature.
- Anyone in the building (students, staff, family members) must wear masks all the time in the building, unless eating at lunch time or drinking water.
- If a student shows signs of sickness, they will be escorted to an isolation room to wait, while you are called to come pick them up. (Remember to update the school - Michelle, teacher, Mr. Yuri - on phone number and email address changes ASAP)
- If multiple students show signs of sickness, they will be sent to wait in the gym to wait, while all parents are called to come pick them up. P.E. classes will be cancelled until the gym is disinfected if this occurs.
- For each time a student is taken home due to sickness, their areas will be thoroughly cleaned, immediately. If a group of students are sent home, their area(s) of school will be temporarily shut down and thoroughly cleaned.
- To limit exposure - students will eat lunches in the classrooms and be responsible for cleaning their areas to help out. Custodians will deep clean in the evenings and on Wednesdays.
- To limit exposure - classes will have recess separately - on one side of the soccer field, at the age-appropriate playground, or the "softball/walking path" field - grades cannot mix together.
- In class - students will be encouraged to remain at their desk, use only their materials, and remain socially distanced. They will take mask breaks as per CDC guidelines and have frequent handwashing sessions.
- Lunches will be delivered to classrooms. Students will be asked to help clean their areas.
- Students are encouraged to use their own water bottles, as there is only one touchless fountain working in the building and no more drinking fountains.
- As per NMPED's July 26 document, DES has entered COVID violations into its discipline matrix. Families must help their child(ren) understand the importance of following rules for safety of all at school.
